*\*Visiting Guest Artist classes, classes with kit included and value classes are not eligible for 2-class discount. Must complete 2nd registration within 1 week of the first registration.*

**Class policies and reminders:** All registrations are final. Class fees reserve your space and pay the instructor for time, training and expertise. If you are unable to attend a class, you may send someone to take your place. You will also be provided with the instructions from the class. Instructors have the option of cancelling a class if there are less than 3 students registered (less than 5 for a boot camp). If 1 Stop Bead Shop cancels a class you are entitled to a refund or class credit to use on another class offering.

Some tools will be available to share when required. You are encouraged to bring your own tools to class. If you are unsure what tools you should bring, consult a staff member. Unless noted, materials are additional and may be purchased anytime prior to class. If a kit is listed, purchase of the kit is required. Kits will be available the night of your class. Kit colors and/or materials may vary from the sample created by the instructor.

**Kits vs. Materials:** 1 Stop Bead Shop determines if a class will require a kit purchase or if students will provide their own materials based upon the complexity of the materials and the cost saving benefits to the students. Class kits are ALWAYS discounted off regular retail. Kits may be available after class for an additional discount. Materials purchased for class may qualify for a discount coupon. Kit costs are listed if known, when you see "est." the kit price is an approximation. (CC=Chinese Crystal, SWR=Swarovski, SF=Silver Filled, SS=Silver)
