

Chain Tassels

Make this quick & easy project using any variety of chains and your choice of bead cap or cone. Large or small, these make great earrings or pendants.

- 1) Choose your chain & bead cap and cut a piece of 24g wire. The bead cap should be deep enough to hide the chain gathering.
- 2) Cut your chain(s) to varying lengths. The number of pieces will depend on the inner diameter of your bead cap and the thickness of your chain.
- 3) Make a loop in the 24g wire using Round Nose Pliers, about 1-2" from one end.
- 4) Gather all the pieces of chain into the loop formed in the 24g wire.



- 5) Complete a wire wrap to secure the chains in place. Trim excess wire.
- 6) Bring wire with looped chains up through the bead cap. Complete another wire wrap to secure the bead cap.
- 7) Attach to an earwires, a bail or directly to your chain or beading wire. For added flair, add a crystal or other bead at a random spot within the tassel.
