

## Classy Pearl Necklace with a Twist!

### Supplies:

- 1 Strand Graduated Glass Pearls (Only \$6!)
- 2 feet 24g Wire
- Beading Wire
- Chain
- Crimps
- Wire Guardians
- Jump Rings
- Clasp



1. Decide how long you want your necklace to be and cut the chain accordingly then cut the chain in half.
2. String the pearls on the beading wire and crimp the ends using the crimp beads & wire guardians. Attach the chain directly to the pearls by using the wire guardians. (Pic1)
3. Attach clasp with jump rings.
4. Securely wrap the 24g wire around one of the crimps. (Pic 3)



5. Pull the wire around the 1st bead and wrap the wire around the beading wire in between the 1st and 2nd bead. (Pic 4)
6. Wrap the wire around the 2nd bead and then wrap the wire on the beading wire in between the 2nd and 3rd bead. Continue on the remaining beads. Finish up by securely wrapping around the 2nd crimp and trim. (Pic 5)
7. Finger shape the wires around the beads if needed.



**(Option:** Use 4 feet of wire and double back around all of the beads!)

This only took about 15 minutes & \$15 to make! Quick, easy & inexpensive!
