**Kaleidoscope Cane** Polymer Clay

In this group project, we'll work together to make a very large cane, which we'll split up and combine to make an unlimited quantity of kaleidoscopic patterned beads. **PREWORK!**  
Materials: At least 8 blocks of conditioned (that's the prework) Premo brand polymer clay: 2 of white, 1 of black, 3 of one color and 2 of a different color. The two colors you choose should be colors that can mix with each other to make a third good color (for example, don't choose turquoise and orange.) Please do not choose metallic, pearl, translucent, or glitter colors. Tools: Bring one used and one brand new polymer clay blade (avoid Sculpey blade w/ handles), an X-Acto knife, and a glass or smooth glazed tile work surface. If you already have one, bring your pasta machine and your acrylic roller.
